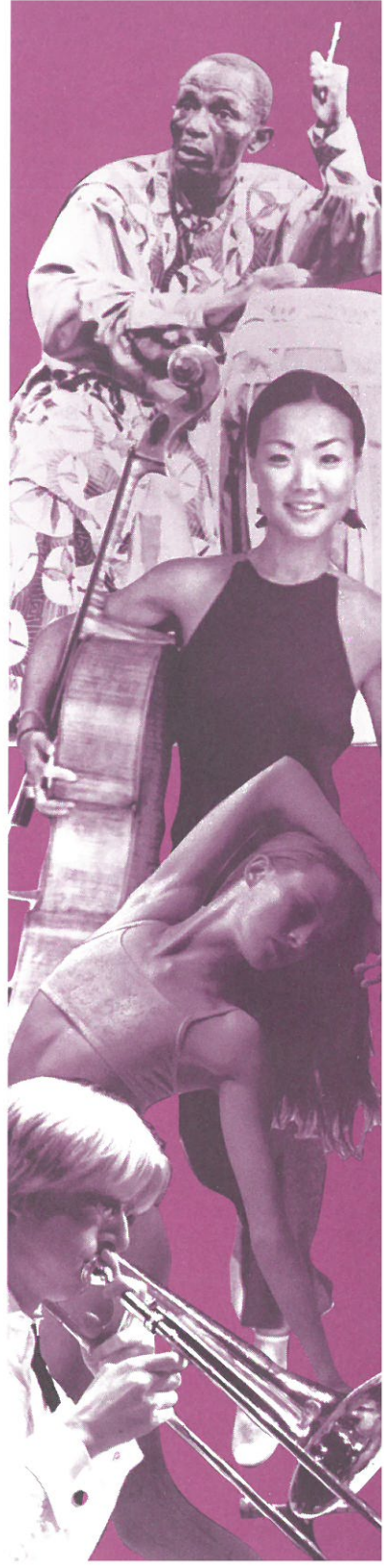

Lenfest Center Facilities

Box Office

The Lenfest box office is accessible from either the fan parking lot directly in front of the building on the corner of Nelson and Glasgow Streets or from the parking garage. Individual tickets will be available for most shows approximately six weeks prior to the performances. The box office will be open from noon to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, and two hours prior to any performance where tickets are sold.

Restrooms

The restrooms are located on Level 1 of the Center and are accessible by elevator or the main lobby staircase.

Assisted Listening System
